Every brother and sister of Christ who attends Mass is sharing in the Eucharistic Sacrifice... our first and primary "ministry" is to pray the Mass! But it makes a big difference in the beauty of our liturgy to have dedicated ministers of Word and Eucharist, as well as altar servers and door greeters. We're getting close to Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ on June 3rd, and I'm looking forward to continuing our growing tradition of a Eucharistic Procession on that day.
